Start Investing in Yourself and In Your Future

A new program will start in **May 2011**. Our CDF program is a 120-hour+ hybrid program using face-to-face classroom sessions, discussions, activities, field trips, interviews, and various e-learning techniques. If you work with students or clients in their career decision making and job seeking, or plan to, this program is for you.

PAYMENT: Applicants can pay by check or credit card. Registration will open in January.

DATES: The first session will be a webinar on 17 May. Classroom sessions are May 20-21 and August 12-13, 2011. Completing all the requirements generally takes about 6 months.

COST: \$1300 includes all materials and instruction with advance payment; \$1400 for late payment. If the class is cancelled due to low enrollment, any payment made is fully refunded.
